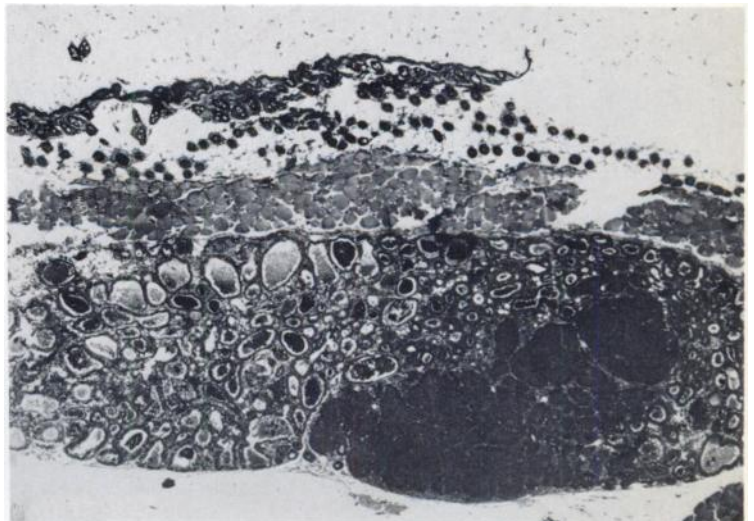
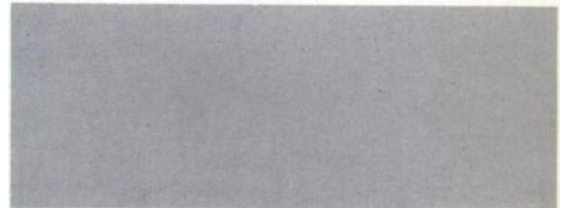

COVER LEGEND

Antoine-Marcellin-Bernard Lacassagne (b. 1884), of Paris, France, has made noteworthy contributions to the endocrine aspects of carcinogenesis and to radiobiology. He was the first to induce mammary cancer in mice by repeated injections of an estrogen (*Compt. Rend. Acad. Sci.*, *195*: 630-632, 1932). The photomicrograph illustrates one of these original induced tumors. The photograph of Lacassagne was taken in 1928.
