### **NCI NEW DRUG SEMINAR**

The Division of Cancer Treatment, National Cancer Institute, has announced the Fifth New Drug Seminar to be held December 16 and 17, 1974, at the Washington Hilton, Washington, D. C. The subject of the seminar will be adriamycin (Doxorubicin), a new antitumor antibiotic originally developed in Italy and soon to be commercially available in the United States. In addition to a review of the drug's initial development, mechanism of action, and initial clinical evaluation in Italy, a series of detailed reports on the American experience in each of the active tumor types will be presented.
