**14th INTERNATIONAL**

The UICC will hold its 14th International Cancer Congress in Budapest, Hungary from August 21-27, 1986. To date, there are 6200 registrants for the meeting which will be devoted to discussion of the most recent developments in experimental and clinical cancer research. The program will consist of: 18 lectures (including the Harold Dorn Memorial Lecture, a keynote, 4 special, and 12 plenary lectures); 82 symposia; 73 round table conferences; 71 panel discussions; 5 audiovisual sessions; and 190 poster discussion sessions. In addition, 4200 abstracts were received and will be presented as posters.

Registration fees are as follows: active members, \$300.00; nurses, \$175.00; students (under 30 years of age), \$150.00; and accompanying persons, \$200.00 (with a 50% discount for children under 12). *Prior to the Congress*, correspondence should be addressed to the Congress Bureau MOTESZ-UICC Congress, Budapest POB. 32, H-1361, Hungary. *During the Congress*, send correspondence to the Congress Centre UICC Congress, % HUNGEXPO, Budapest POB. 44, H-1441, Hungary.
