## Erratum

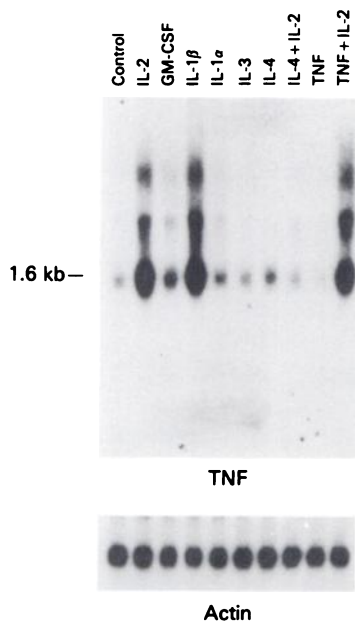


Fig. 2. Effect of cytokines on the expression of TNF mRNA. Total cellular RNA was obtained from PBMC, cultured untreated or treated with various cytokines at 1000 units/ml for 20 h. Northern blots were hybridized with  $^{32}$ P-labeled TNF cDNA probes. *kb*, kilobases.

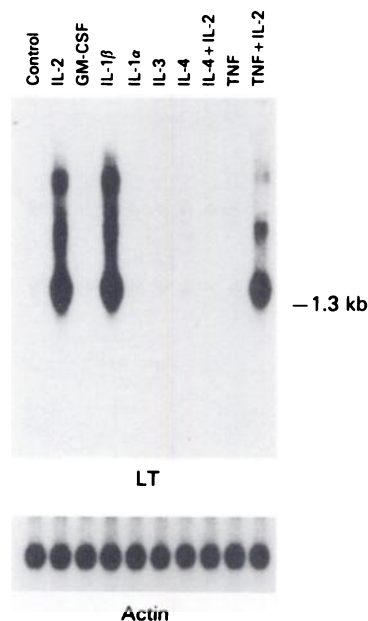


Fig. 3. Effect of cytokines on the expression of LT mRNA. Experimental details are the same as in Fig. 2. Northern blots were successively hybridized with  $^{32}$ P-labeled LT and human  $\gamma$ -actin probes. *kb*, kilobases.

In the article by A. Kasid *et al.*, entitled "Cytokine Regulation of Tumor Necrosis Factor- $\alpha$  and - $\beta$  (Lymphotoxin)-Messenger RNA Expression in Human Peripheral Blood Mononuclear Cells," which was published in the August 15, 1990 issue of *Cancer Research* (pp. 5072–5076), Figures 2 and 3 contained mistakes resulting from their initial preparation. The corrected figures with their legends appear below.

The authors note that the point of the experiments demonstrated in these figures, *i.e.*, that interleukin 4 inhibits interleukin 2 induction of tumor necrosis factor and lymphotoxin messenger RNA in peripheral blood mononuclear cells, is correct and remains unchanged.
