CONFERENCE ON "THE ACTINOMYCINS AND THEIR IMPORTANCE IN THE TREATMENT OF TUMORS IN ANIMALS AND MAN"

This conference will be held under the auspices of The New York Academy of Sciences at the Barbizon-Plaza Hotel in New York City on Thursday, March 31, and Friday, April 1, 1960. Doctor Selman A. Waksman of the Institute of Microbiology, Rutgers University, will serve as Conference Chairman.

The Thursday afternoon program will be on "Microbiology and Chemistry of the Actinomycins." The after-dinner address in the evening will be given by Dr. Waksman on "The Impact of Microbiology on Medicine and

Public Health." The two sessions on Friday will be concerned with "Pharmacology and Activity in Animals," in the forenoon, and "The Clinical Significance of the Actinomycins," the afternoon topic.
