GORDON RESEARCH CONFERENCE ON CANCER

The Gordon Research Conference on Cancer for 1965 will be held from August 30 to September 3, 1965 at Colby Junior College, New London, New Hampshire.

The Gordon conferences were established to stimulate research in universities, research foundations, and industrial laboratories. This purpose is achieved by an informal type of meeting consisting of scheduled speakers and discussion groups. Sufficient time is available to stimulate informal discussion among the members of each conference. This type of meeting is a valuable means of disseminating information and ideas to an extent that could not be achieved through the usual channels of publication and presentation at scientific meetings.

Attendance at the conference is by application. Individuals interested in attending the conference are requested to send their applications to the Director at least 2 months prior to the date of the conference. *All applications must be submitted in duplicate on the standard application form which may be obtained by writing to the office of the Director.* This procedure is important, because certain specific information is required in order that a fair and equitable decision on the application may be made. Attendance at each conference is limited to approximately 100 conferees.
