PROTIDES OF THE BIOLOGICAL FLUIDS

The XXIVth Annual Colloquium on Protides of the Biological Fluids will be held in Brugge, Belgium, from April 27 to May 1, 1976. The following topics will be covered during the meeting: pregnancy-associated proteins; carcino-fetal and carcino-placental proteins; and detection and quantitation of proteins by molecular amplification. FIRST INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON HLA AND DISEASE

The First International Symposium on *HLA* and Disease: Predisposition to Disease and Clinical Implications will be held from June 23 to 25, 1976, at the Palais des Congrès, Paris, France. Physicians and biologists will meet to discuss the biological significance and practical implications of the association between *HLA* antigens and disease in nosology, diagnosis, and preventive therapeutics. The Symposium is composed of: a plenary session with several lectures followed by round table discussion of 6 topics; 10 different workshops according to clinical speciality in which original communications will be discussed and reports will be prepared on the various diseases associated with *HLA* for each speciality; and a plenary session in which the workshop reports will be presented. A book including the lectures, workshop reports, and a table of relative risks will be edited by Munksgaard (Copenhagen). Communications will be published in an international scientific journal.
