

confrontation of high-quality publications pertinent to leukemia and closely related diseases. There will be no restriction as to the specific field of interest of the authors, the methods, the material (human as well as animal), the approach (clinical, biological, or dealing with pure basic sciences), as long as the data are experimental and of high standard. Contributions that do not deal directly with leukemia but that deal with normal blood and tissue as well as with cell biology at large are highly welcome insofar as they carry a message of general interest for the understanding of the deranged mechanisms of the biology of the leukemic cell. Such would be papers dealing with differentiation of molecular biology of growth control.

The Editors and the publishers welcome the submission of original research papers not exceeding 10 to 20 pages of double-spaced typescript. Papers should be written in English and should be submitted in triplicate to Dr. S. A. Killman, Professor of Medicine, Department of Medicine A, Rigshospitalet, University Hospital of Copenhagen, DK-2100 Copenhagen, Denmark. Detailed "Instructions to Authors" may be obtained from the Editors.

### **SURVEY COURSE IN IMMUNOLOGY**

The Annual Survey Course in Immunology, sponsored by the American Association of Immunologists, will be held at the Frederick Cancer Research Center and Hood College, Frederick, Maryland, July 18 through July 29, 1977.

The course is intended primarily for university or college instructors who need to expand their breadth of knowledge in the field of immunology. The number of participants will be limited to approximately 100, and selection will be on a competitive basis. Applicants should prepare a document containing the following information: (1) curriculum vitae; (2) current research and teaching activities; (3) background in immunology; and (4) reasons for wanting to enroll in the course. The document should be submitted in duplicate to Dr. M. G. Hanna, Jr., Director of Basic Research, Frederick Cancer Research Center, P. O. Box B, Frederick, Maryland 21701, no later than March 1, 1977. There are no formal application blanks.

The registration fee is \$125. Dormitory-type facilities are available at nominal charge to the applicant. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded.
