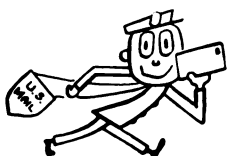

The Cancer Research Center and the Department of Oncology at the University of Missouri-Columbia are searching for a basic science investigator to serve as Scientific Director of the Cancer Research Center and Director of the Division of Cancer Biology within the Department of Oncology. An academic appointment is available at the Associate Professor or Professor level in the Department of Oncology, and in such other department jointly as might be desirable. A background in tumor immunology or chemical carcinogenesis is preferred.
