**NATIONAL CONFERENCE
ON CANCER PREVENTION
AND DETECTION**

A national conference on cancer prevention and detection, sponsored by the American Cancer Society, will be held April 17 through 19, 1980, at the Palmer House, Chicago, Illinois. Experts representing various disciplines will present current ideas on exogenous and endogenous factors in cancer causation and methods of cancer prevention and detection. Controversial areas in these fields will be examined, and the economic impact of the various cancer control programs will be reviewed. The goal of this conference is to provide information which will stimulate members of the medical profession to participate in cancer control activities in prevention and detection. Attendance is limited to physicians, dentists, medical students, and cancer research investigators at the doctoral level. There is no registration fee, but advance registration is requested. The conference is approved for 14½ credit hours in Category 1 of the Physician's Recognition Award of the American Medical Association and is acceptable for 14½ prescribed hours by the American Academy of Family Physicians.
