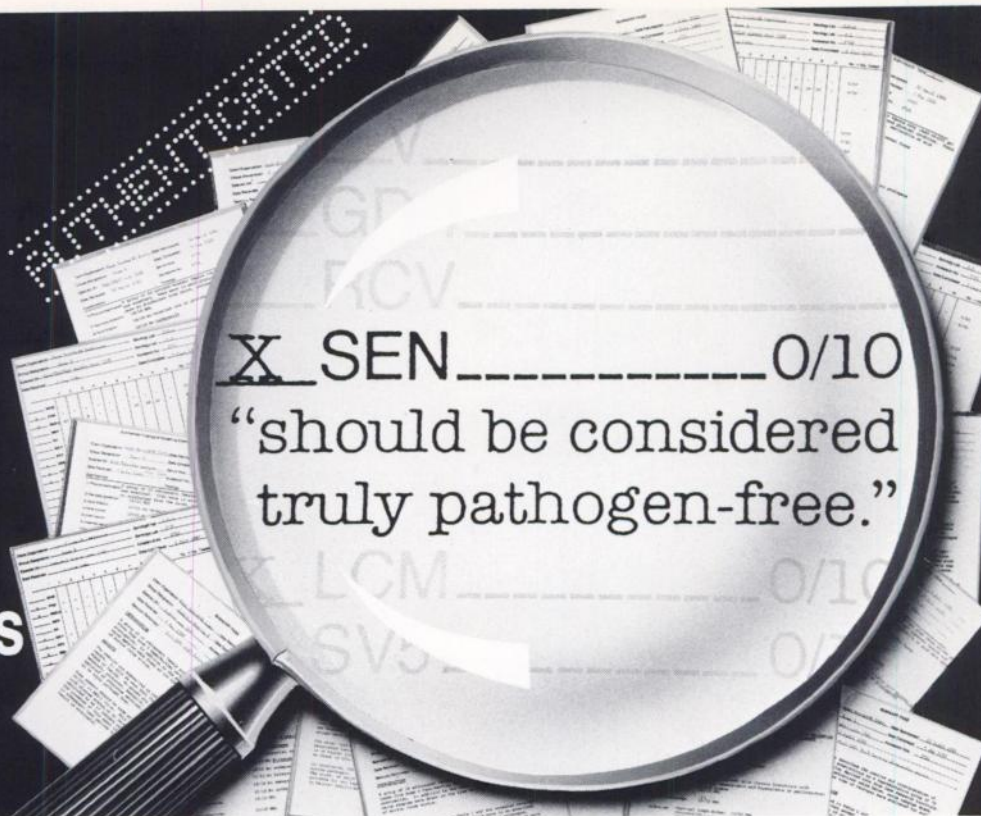

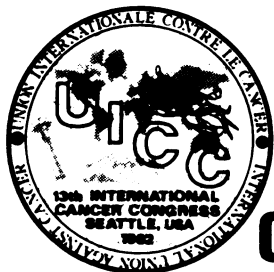

The International Cancer Congress is held every four years under the auspices of the International Union Against Cancer (UICC). It is a forum for a worldwide exchange of ideas on, advances in, and approaches to cancer research, therapy, control, and prevention. The scientific program, designed to address the multifaceted needs of physicians, scientists, dentists, nurses, other allied health professionals, and volunteers involved in cancer control, includes plenary lectures, symposia, seminars, round table discussions, postgraduate courses, proffered paper (slide) sessions, poster presentations, panels, scientific films, and scientific and commercial exhibits.

All persons working in cancer-related fields are invited to register as Members of the Congress. Registration fees for Members are \$210 until January 29, 1982; \$235 between January 30 and August 31, 1982; and \$260 after September 1, 1982. Students and guests are also invited: fees are \$100, \$125, and \$150.
