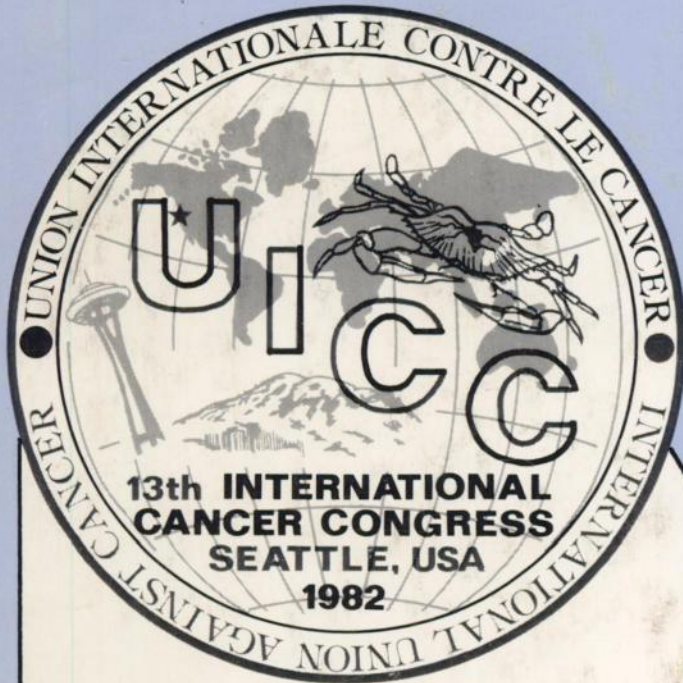

4, 6-DIOXOHEPTANOIC ACID AN INHIBITOR OF HEME BIOSYNTHESIS

4, 6-Dioxoheptanoic Acid (Succinyl Acetone) has been shown to inhibit the second enzyme of the heme pathway, δ -aminolevulinic acid dehydratase (ALA). Inhibition of ALA dehydratase by 4, 6-Dioxoheptanoic Acid in murine erythroleukemia cells was seen in concentrations as low as 10^{-8} M (23.9% inhibition) and at 10^{-4} M there was 100% inhibition. It has also been shown that when 4, 6-Dioxoheptanoic Acid is added to cultures of MEL cells in the presence of dimethylsulfoxide (DMSO) hemoglobin content was progressively depressed by increasing concentrations of 4, 6-Dioxoheptanoic Acid.

The Thirteenth International Cancer Congress, sponsored by the International Union Against Cancer (UICC), will meet in Seattle, September 8 through 15, 1982.

The Congresses provide a forum for the worldwide exchange of ideas, techniques, and results of work

toward the eventual prevention and cure of cancer. Over 12,000 delegates from 95 nations are expected to attend.

Some of the subjects to be emphasized are: environment and cancer, advances in cancer diagnosis, the role of health care systems, the advanced cancer patient, changing lifestyles and cancer, and mass communications and cancer control. These topics will be considered in a variety of formats, including 9 general symposia, 48 specialized and interdisciplinary symposia, post-graduate courses, seminars, round-table discussions, films, proffered papers, posters, and panels. The USA National Program Committee is chaired by Dr. Enrico Mihich, Roswell Park Memorial Institute, Buffalo, New York.
