**SEVENTY-FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION FOR CANCER RESEARCH, INC.**

The scientific sessions of the 75th Annual Meeting of the American Association for Cancer Research, Inc. will be held at the Sheraton Centre Hotel, Toronto, Ontario, from 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, May 9, 1984, until 1:00 p.m., Saturday, May 12, 1984. This meeting will be preceded by that of the American Society of Clinical Oncology to be held in the same hotel on May 6-8, 1984.

Members and interested nonmembers will be able to preregister for the 1984 meeting. Advance registration forms will be mailed to members as part of the advance program brochure in late summer. Additional forms may be obtained by writing the office of the American Association for Cancer Research.

On-site registration for the Annual Meeting will be conducted at the Sheraton Centre Hotel and will take place during the afternoon and evening of Tuesday, May 8, 1984 and throughout the course of the meeting.

By action of the Board of Directors, a registration fee of US\$40.00/C\$50.00 will be charged each member attending the scientific sessions. The registration fee for nonmembers will be US\$50.00/C\$62.50. A special rate of US\$20.00/C\$25.00 will be charged to predoctoral students who present a statement, signed by the registrar, dean, or department head of their university or college on official letterhead, confirming their status. Admission to the scientific sessions will be restricted to properly registered persons.

The advance program brochure will also provide details on the regulations for submission of abstracts and presentation of papers will include the official abstract form and hotel reservation cards. The deadline for receipt of abstracts, December 1, 1983 will be enforced strictly. Abstracts that are submitted in conformity with the regulations and considered of acceptable quality will be published in the March 1984 *Proceedings of the American Association for Cancer Research*, which will be mailed by the publisher to all paid-up subscribers to the journal *Cancer Research*.
