# AMERICAN ASSOCIATION FOR CANCER RESEARCH 1988 EMPLOYMENT REGISTER FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS

## Introduction

The AACR Board of Directors has enthusiastically approved an expansion of the Association's Employment Register. This is intended to attract young scientists to the Association, increase interest in AACR programs, and provide a valuable service to all cancer researchers, both senior and junior investigators. The current expansion is part of an effort to create a year-round employment register which will be completely active by early 1989.

The AACR has been operating a limited employment register since 1983 with a fee structure that has permitted only the listing of positions and candidates at the annual meeting. New services this year include the scheduling of interviews at the upcoming annual meeting in New Orleans by AACR staff and the publication of brief advertisements describing available candidates and positions in the *Proceedings of the American Association for Cancer Research* and in two issues of *Cancer Research*. Registration forms for the 1988 employment register follow these instructions. In this initial year of an expanded register fees have been set at or close to their previous levels:

\$10 for each candidate registration  
\$35 for each position listing

## Instructions for Candidates

1. Supply all information requested on the attached candidate registration form.
2. Type a short description of your background and the position you are seeking in the 5 x 1 1/4" box provided. Do not include your name; the AACR will assign identification numbers to all candidate listings. Please type carefully; this description will be printed by direct photoreproduction as described in the section below entitled "Publication of Listings."
3. Enclose the original form plus 11 copies.
4. Enclose payment of \$10. Checks should be issued in U.S. dollars, drawn on a U.S. bank, and made payable to AACR, Inc.
5. Candidate registration forms will be accepted in the Association Office until May 11, 1988. Registration will also be possible at the annual meeting in New Orleans.

## Scheduling of Interviews

The AACR will set aside space in the New Orleans Convention Center, the site of the annual meeting's scientific sessions, for interviews which will be scheduled at mutually agreeable times during the following hours: Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, May 25-27, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday, May 28, from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. To preserve anonymity each candidate and employer will receive an identification number. Registrants who submit their forms and fees by the deadline of May 11, 1988, will receive from the AACR an acknowledgment which contains their identification number and a scheduling card on which they may indicate their availability for interviews.

## Publication of Listings

Short advertisements describing each candidate and position listing will be published in Volume 29 (1988) of the *Proceedings of the American Association for Cancer Research* and in the September 1, and December 1, 1988, issues of *Cancer Research*. The attached forms contain space for these advertisements which will be printed by direct photoreproduction. Advertisements for available positions should contain the name and address of the person conducting the job search, and candidates will be able to communicate with that person directly. Candidate advertisements will be anonymous. The AACR will provide the candidate's complete form to prospective employers.

The employment register forms were mailed to all AACR members in January. Due to the early publication date of the *Proceedings*, it is no longer possible to accept advertisements for this document. However, all advertisements submitted before or during the meeting will be published in the two issues of *Cancer Research*. Registrants wishing to withdraw their advertisements must submit written requests to that effect to the Association Office by July 5, 1988, for the September issue and by October 3, 1988, for the December issue. All participants in the employment register are urged to notify the Association immediately of any change in their status so that all listings will remain current.

## Further Information

Members and friends of the AACR are urged to participate in the 1988 Employment Register by submitting the attached forms to the Association by May 11, 1988. The Board of Directors feels strongly that an enhanced employment service will attract students into the field of cancer research and provide a significant service to current and potential members.
