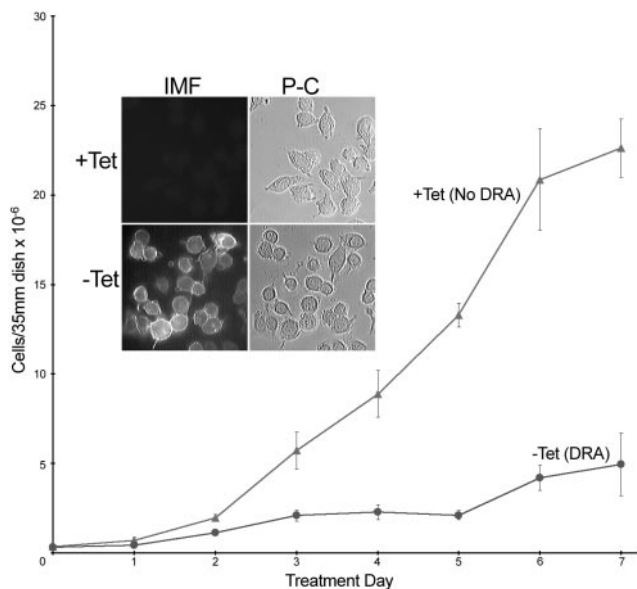


Fig. 2. Effect of inducible *DRA* expression on cellular growth. A DLD-1 transfectant expressing an inducible *DRA* plasmid (pUHD10-3hygroDRA) and the tetracycline repressor was grown in the presence (▲) or absence (●) of tetracycline to measure growth rate. Growth curve data represent triplicates from one experiment; bars, SD. Inset, immunofluorescence (IMF) staining of DLD-1/DRA clone expressing pUHD10-3hygroDRA and the tetracycline repressor using a polyclonal *DRA* antibody in the presence (+Tet) or absence (-Tet) of tetracycline. Phase contrast (P-C) of the field is shown.
